

## **Soccer Nets Pick up / Drop Off Procedure**

All nets will be available at the home of Andrea Mandrigues located at 3548 Bodega Court, Arden Park. Andrea's phone is 821-4306.

### **Friday Night Games (U-6)**

The home team is responsible for pick up and set up of the nets and flags. (Cresta uses the PUGG goals) Please return the nets the same evening as other teams will need the nets first thing on Saturday mornings. There is a binder available to sign in and out for the nets.

### **Saturday Games (U-8 and up)**

Included in your game packet will be a Nets Up / Down flyer that outlines the dates that your team is responsible to pick up / set up nets or take down/return nets. This applies to **HOME GAMES only**. Please make note of it. If you are the first team on the field that day you will be responsible for putting up the nets. Nets should be up no later than 20 minutes before game time. If you are the last team on the field, your team is responsible for taking down the nets and returning them to the Nets Coordinators home.

### **Soccer Nets Set-Up Guide**

Each soccer net bag contains two nets, one for each goal, along with Velcro straps, stakes and a hammer.

Before starting, ensure the seam of the net is positioned to run from the top of the goal on either side, sloping down to the rear of the goal.

- \* To install the net, start with the top of the goal, attaching the net to clips, which are already affixed to the goal, or attach with Velcro straps. Many nets have Velcro straps tied onto them already in the proper positions.
- \* Once the top of the net is attached, pull the net taut across the back of the goal as you attach the sides of the net to the goal.
- \* Stake or attach the nets to the bottom side rails of the goal.
- \* Stake the net across the rear of the goal, again pulling taut, but not too tight.

Please be sure to place all contents back in the bag before returning. All nets should be returned the same day so that they can be available to the field for next use. Should anything be missing please leave a note so that items can be replaced.
